QUALIFICATIONS

Awarding scholarships to women is one way in which AAUW Sacramento encourages women to pursue a higher education. An applicant must meet all of the following qualifications:

- 1) Be a woman 25 years of age or older by September 1, 2018
- 2) Be a resident of Sacramento County and be enrolled at one of the following colleges:
 - American River College
 - Folsom Lake College
 - Cosumnes River College
 - Sacramento City College
 - California State University, Sacramento
- 3) Be scheduled to take at least six (6) units in Fall 2018 at one of the above five colleges
- 4) Be scheduled to graduate no earlier than May 2019
- 5) Have completed at least twelve (12) units of credit from an accredited college or university with a Grade Point Average of 3.0 or higher in college level classes (not remedial and/or ESL)
- 6) Be in pursuit of her first baccalaureate degree
- 7) Have clearly defined educational goals
- 8) Demonstrate evidence of financial need
- 9) Be able and willing to attend one AAUW Sacramento Branch meeting to speak briefly about her course of study and career goals

APPLICATION DOCUMENTS TO SUBMIT:

- (1) Complete, signed application.
- (2) Unofficial transcripts from at least one accredited college or university that confirm completion of at least 12 or more units of college level courses and cumulative GPA.
- (3) Proof of Spring 2018 semester enrollment in at least six units of college level courses. Official transcripts and proof of Fall 2019 enrollment will be required before the award is paid.
- (4) Two letters of recommendation on letterhead from individuals such as teachers, professors, counselors or employers who can attest to your potential for success. At least one letter must be from a college or university instructor. Letters may report the applicant's participation in volunteer work or employment history, notable skills, work habits, integrity, leadership skills or other abilities. Submit only two letters.

Applications must be emailed or postmarked no later than March 5, 2018 INCOMPLETE OR LATE APPLICATIONS MAY BE DISQUALIFIED
