


- AAUW reached over **14 million** people in over **1200 media articles and outlets in 2019** including The New York Times, The Washington Post, National Public Radio, MSNBC, Time, Newsweek, Money, Fortune, The Oprah Magazine and more. We also raised our profile on social media platforms, garnering over 5 million impressions on Facebook, Instagram, LinkedIn and Twitter.
- For the 2019–20 academic year, AAUW is awarding \$4 million in fellowships and grants to **259 women and community projects** to advance educational and professional opportunities for women in the United States and around the globe. AAUW members have been so generous over the years that the organization now has sufficient funding to support fellows and grantees for the next 50 years.
- We recently updated our hallmark study, The Simple Truth About the Gender Pay Gap, with new census data showing that women still earn about 82 cents for every dollar paid to men. In the latest version of our report Deeper in Debt, we showed that women now hold almost two-thirds of the country's \$1.4-trillion student debt. And our latest research report, Limiting Our Livelihoods, indicates that sexual harassment can have long-term, negative repercussions on women's health, economic security and access to leadership positions.
- We're commemorating the 100th anniversary of the 19th Amendment and the 55th anniversary of the Voting Rights Act in 2020 by launching a project called "Every Voice. Every Vote."

We are proud of the accomplishments that you helped make possible. These efforts remind us why we are passionate members of AAUW — and we will not stop here. As women gain access to education, economic security, and leadership positions, we must build on our efforts to further that progress. Looking toward the future, we aim to solidify AAUW's position as a global leader on equity. With a focus on impact, we will strive to raise awareness of what equity means in the 21st century and plot our path to the future to which everyone can contribute.
