<u>Suggestion for what to write</u>: (These are suggestions of some facts and questions you might include)
<u>Facts</u>: In 2020, Virginia became the 38<sup>th</sup> State to ratify the Equal Rights Amendment, thus satisfying the ¾'s of states requirement. As soon as the Virginia vote was sent to the National Archives, Trump administration prevented certification of the Amendment, stating it had missed the congressional deadline in 1982. However, we have the example of the 27<sup>th</sup> amendment which took 203 years to be ratified.

- Additionally, we know that the ERA is the most popular Amendment never published, according to the National Archives.
- President, Joe Biden, campaigned on a promise to get the ERA/28<sup>th</sup> Amendment into the U. S.
   Constitution. He has, also, publicly supported congressional resolutions that nullify the arbitrary deadline.
- Lastly, although five (5) states voted to rescind their ratification, no state legislature has ever been successful rescinding a vote of ratification.

Questions: Why isn't the 28th Amendment part of the U. S. Constitution?

- Why doesn't President Biden tell his new Archivist, Colleen Shogan, to publish the amendment?
- Would we have the Dobbs decision with the Equal Rights Amendment as a part of our Constitution?
- Why don't national news reporters ask Biden about the ERA at news conferences?
- If women political leaders and military members swear to protect the Constitution, why aren't they protected by it?
- Is there a political agenda preventing the certification and publication of the Equal Rights Amendment?
