QUALIFICATIONS

Awarding scholarships to women is one way that AAUW Sacramento encourages women to pursue a higher education. To qualify, applicants must

- 1) Be women 25 years of age or older by September 1, 2024
- 2) Live in Sacramento County and be enrolled at one of the following colleges:
 - · American River College
 - Folsom Lake College
 - · Cosumnes River College
 - · Sacramento City College
 - · California State University, Sacramento
 - UC Davis
- 3) Enroll in at least six (6) units in Fall 2024 at one of the above six colleges
- 4) Graduate no earlier than May 2025
- 5) Have completed at least twelve (12) units of credit from an accredited college or university with a Grade Point average of 3.0 or higher in college level classes (not remedial and/or ESL)
- 6) Be pursuing her first bachelor's degree with clearly defined educational goals
- 7) Show financial need
- 8) Attend an AAUW Sacramento Branch meeting in Fall 2024 to speak briefly about her course of study and career goals



REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- (1) Complete and signed application.
- (2) Unofficial transcripts from at least one accredited college or university that confirm completion of at least 12 or more units of college level courses and cumulative GPA.
- (3) Proof of current semester enrollment in at least six units of college level courses. Official transcripts and proof of Fall 2024 enrollment will be required before the award is paid.
- (4) Two letters of recommendation on letterhead from individuals such as professors, counselors or employers who can attest to your potential for success. At least one letter must be from a college or university instructor who has recent experience with the student in the classroom. Letters may report the applicant's participation in volunteer work or employment history, notable skills, work habits, integrity, leadership skills or other abilities. Submit only two letters.
- (5) A resume with your job history, volunteer work, and/or community activities.
- (6) In your personal statement, describe your **personal goals, achievements and career objectives**. Include relevant biographical information. The statement should be at least one, but no more than the two pages provided at the end of the application form.

Application materials must be submitted no later than 11:59 p.m. March 31, 2024, and will be kept confidential within the committee

Finalists will be required to participate in virtual interviews
